3. Purpose of collecting and processing personal data

4. What kind of information do we collect?

Information and content you provide. We collect the information you provide via electronic sign-up forms when signing-up for our services, as well as other information provided by you when entering into an agreement with us.

We do not collect personal data about you from other sources not provided by you.

5. Use and transfer of personal data

Employees of TalentMiles Ab have access to the data collected. Your name as well as other necessary information, for example allergies, may be shared with hired vendors, such as hotels and restaurants, if needed. Personal data will not be shared with other third parties. Personal data will not be stored outside the EU or EEA, and will not be shared with third parties outside the EU or EEA.

6. Safety of data

Our database containing your personal data is protected at all times by appropriate technical and organisational measures to prevent its loss and abuse. It is stored in a safe operational environment which is not accessible to the public.

7. What rights do you have?

You have a legal right to inspect what data we have collected about you. You also have the right to demand that incorrect, incomplete, unnecessary or outdated personal data be corrected or removed.
